BATTLE for NEWBURY, SPENCER-PEIRCE-LITTLE FARM

8 - 9 June 2019

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Robert Falotico at **The Battle for Newbury** encampment at the Spencer-Peirce-Little Farm in Newbury, MA, Saturday–Sunday 8 - 9 June, 2019 (see: <http://battlefornewbury.redcoat.org/>).

Dress shall be No. 2 for all ranks, gaiter style at the discretion of CO'Y COs (Officers may wear shoes and gaiters in lieu of boots). ALL firelocks are to be equipped with flints and hammerstalls as there will be firing. Companies also shall bring caps, hats, and forage caps.

Spencer-Peirce-Little farm is located at **5 Little's Lane, Newbury, MA**. Travel is by private vehicle and car-pooling is recommended. Aerial views of the site layout can be found here: <http://battlefornewbury.redcoat.org/sitemap.html> .

The Camp Kitchen will provide the following:

- 3 meals on Saturday
- 2 meals on Sunday

The British encampment will be behind and to the left of the farmhouse. Report to the Camp QM upon arrival for directions to the Tenth tent row. As normal, to lesson traffic, please unload your gear and then park your vehicle in the designated area (directions will be provided at the site; *see link to site layout above*). Once you have your tent erected, please report to the Tenth kitchen to assist with set-up there.

Release from Liability
