14:00 hrs: Cannon Salute. Call to Assembly, Tactical with HM Forces on Gas House Beach, Camp closes to Public
15:00 hrs: Cannon Salute, Camp re-opens.
16:00 hrs: Cannon salute followed by Last Man Standing Contest (bottle of rum for winner). Keg untapped.
17:00 hrs: Cannon salute to close camp followed by sea chanties.
18:00 hrs: Dinner (courtesy of GMR mess) with music, followed by dancing NOTE: Time of Dinner still open. **Need a head count of those staying for dinner.**
20:00 hrs: Revelry and Tavern
