Battle of Bunker Hill
22 - 24 JULY

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Robert Falotico for the *Battle of Bunker Hill* at The American Heritage Museum in Hudson, MA on Friday July 22 – Sunday July 24.

Uniform is No. 2. Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Companies should bring caps, hats, and forage caps. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. The museum's address is: *568 Main Street, Hudson, MA*. Arrival is after 08:00 hrs on Friday and throughout the day. If arriving on Saturday or Sunday, arrive between 07:00 hrs and 08:30 hrs as the museum opens at 09:00 hrs.

Parking is on site (see map on the next page). Reenactors will have access to the tour the museum.

For those camping, the Camp QM will assign you a place for your tent. Be ready to lend a hand for kitchen set-up Friday evening as well as take down on Sunday. A recommended packing list is available for those who will be camping for the first time and as a reminder for the rest of us.

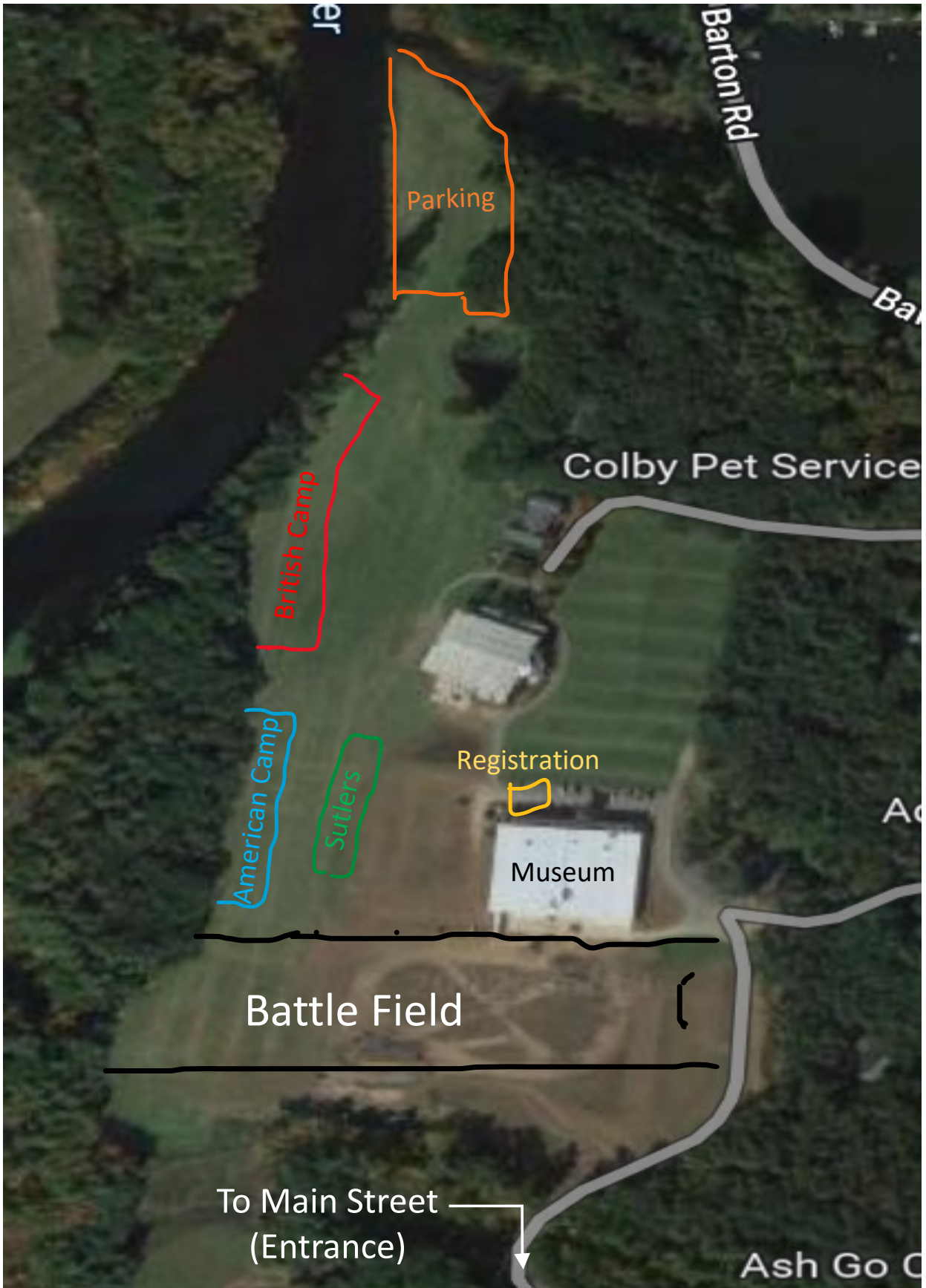
