PARKER'S REVENGE PROGRAM

7 OCTOBER 2017

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Robert Falotico for *Parker's Revenge: The New Evidence*, at the Minute Man National Historic Park visitor center, on Saturday 7 October.

Uniform is No. 2. Since there will be firing and we will be in a National Park, all muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Line and Staff officers to wear shoes with gaiters or boots. Companies should bring both caps and hats.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. The MMNHP visitor center does not have a street address. GPS coordinates are: 42.448798, -71.273326

Directions by Car:

- From I-95: Take exit 30B. You will be on Route 2A west. The park is 1-mile west off ramp.
- From MassPike: Take I-95 Exit (exit 14) and follow above directions.
- From Route 2: Follow Route 2 to I-95 North. Proceed north one exit to 30B. Follow directions above.

Schedule:

1130 - 1200hrs: Arrival at MMNHP.

1200hrs: Formation, inspection of arms, powder distribution, and walk through.

13:00 – 1315hrs: Audience gathers in the minute Man Visitor Center auditorium for an overview presentation by Meg Watters about the Parker's Revenge Project.

1315 – 1330hrs: We bring the group out to the main parking area and Battle Road Trail. We will talk briefly about the landscape and the lead-up to the battle.

1330 – 1350hrs: Volunteers from the audience will choose sides and accompany the reenactors to the battle site for a dry-run

1250 – 1400hrs: We "re-set," get the visitors behind a rope barrier along the bridle path and the reenactors re-create the skirmish in real time with blank charges.
