Saturday 6 October

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Robert Falotico for *Boston Occupied: The Redcoats are Coming Again*, in Boston, MA, on Saturday 6 October. This is the kick-off event in preparation for our Nation's upcoming *Sestercentennial* in 2026, and an excellent event for us in our *Semicentennial* year.

Uniform is No. 2. Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Line and Staff officers to wear shoes with gaiters or boots. Companies should bring both caps and hats. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. Parking will be at Post Office Square Garage, *Zero Post Office Square, Boston, MA 02109*. All vehicles will be supplied with free parking.

Schedule for the Day

07:00 – 07:30 hrs: Arrive at Post Office Square Garage

07:30 – 08:00 hrs: Walk to Liberty Star berth, approximately 10 minutes

08:00 hrs: Arrive at Liberty Star berth, *67 Long Wharf, Boston, MA*

08:30 hrs: Board Liberty Star, sail out to Castle Island and back to Long Wharf, 10th Officers to set up HQ at Chart House

9:30 hrs: Disembark Liberty Star at Long Wharf
Registration at Chart House, receive parking vouchers, etc.
Refreshments supplied by Chart House, bathrooms at Chart House and Marriott Hotel

10:30 hrs: Form up on Long Wharf at Compass Rose.
Lieutenant Colonel Robert Falotico will be in command of the Crown Forces; Major Michal Graves as Adjutant, 100+ Redcoats expected.
10th to bring Silk Colours, weather permitting

- 10:45 hrs: Step off for Parade to Boston Common
Parade is 1+ mile in length, traffic control to be provided by Boston Police. We will march down center of streets!!
- March up State Street to Old State House. Stop at Old State House, Colonial Governor says few words. Royal Artillery 7th Co. to post Gun at door of Old State House
- 11:00 hrs: Step off from Old State House down Devonshire Street
Continue to Otis Street, then take right onto Summer Street, then right onto Washington Street, then proceed to steps at corner of Franklin and Washington just down the street from South Meeting House. Few speeches: UK Counsel General, Park Service, Col Dalrymple, John Hancock, etc.
- Continue by making left onto Bromfield Street then left onto Tremont Street. Enter the Common at corner of Park Street, continue down mall past Visitor Center, continue to far side of Common to Camp and Parade Grounds
- 12:30 hrs: Box lunch provided by Roche Bros.
- 13:00 hrs: Begin drilling, demonstrations, interactions with the Public.
During the day Sentry's will be posted at Common, Old State House and South Meeting House (Organized by Major Graves, 10th can participate if interested).
- 15:00 hrs: Firing demo on Common (Powder provided by Park Service – 5 rounds per soldier)
- 16:00 hrs: Trooping of 10th Colours on Common.
- 17:00 hrs: Formal activities end.
- 17:00 - ? hrs: Dinner and libations
Meal/drink discount vouchers for Restaurants and Pubs at Downtown Crossing (easy walk from Common)
- 20:00 hrs: Troops/Public interactions at Democracy Brewing Co. on Temple Street just off Tremont (optional). This is Oktoberfest Weekend too!
