### **BATTLE of CHASE FARM**

21 October 2017

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Robert Falotico for the **Battle of Chase Farm** in Lincoln, RI on Saturday 21 October 2017.

Although this is scheduled as a one-day event, participants are welcome to camp Saturday night. Wood, straw and water will be provided. There will be a Sunday morning tactical.

Dress shall be No. 2 for all ranks (Officers may wear shoes and gaiters in lieu of boots). ALL firelocks are to be equipped with flints flashguards, and hammerstalls as there will be firing. Troops shall bring both hats and company caps as well as a bag lunch, snacks, and water for the day. Those camping into Sunday will need to bring additional food and water.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is recommended. The address is: 667 Great Road, Lincoln, RI. From the north, take I95 south to I295. Follow I295 south to exit 9A, 146 south. Continue on 146 south and exit onto 123 east, which is called Breakneck Road. Follow this road, which will become Great Road, for approximately 1.2 miles; the farm will be on the left.
