The Command Staff met by teleconference today, Sunday March 15th, to discuss how we will continue to maintain the Regiment in the face of the ongoing COVID-19 outbreak and associated cancellations. The results of that meeting are summarized below.

First and foremost, the most important thing that we all can do is to take care of ourselves and our families, keep everyone healthy so we are all ready to go once this thing does pass, and it will.

Second, we decided the best thing we can do is to maintain regular communication between the Command Staff and the Regiment as a whole. To that end, the Command Staff will be teleconferencing each Sunday afternoon and reporting out our discussions immediately thereafter. Likewise, Company CO's/NCO's will maintain regular communication within their companies.

Some specifics:

- Company CO's/NCO's will arrange individual training sessions with their recruits so we can continue in preparing them for being sworn as full members without having to meet in larger numbers.
- The QM staff also will make themselves available to individuals and small groups to work on kit, again avoiding meeting in larger numbers.
- Everyone should keep an eye on the schedule as it most certainly will be in flux in the near future. Major Graves will send out update notices as needed.
- We stand to lose roughly \$5500.00 through the end of May depending on which, if any more, of our scheduled, paid parades are cancelled. Thus, we will be seeking additional paid events to make-up for these losses. Please be ready and flexible to participate in these events if and when they come. Remember that we do not charge dues, but depend on paid events to pay the bills.
- Since our early scheduled events are in threat of being cancelled, we will be looking into some form of a "shakedown" event once we are able to fully commence for the season.
- Jeffery Meriwether has been appointed "Training Officer" and advanced to the rank of Major. He will be working with Sjt. Major Mental to arrange additional training activities as needed.
- Finally, the QM staff needs assistance with leather work. Those interested in helping out with this should contact Paul O'Shaughnessy.
