Minutes of the 29 March Command Staff Teleconference submitted by Major Meriwether:

- No news on events in May. Reminder, events through April are cancelled.
- Company check-in:
 1. Light Infantry-no work this week with soldiers, although LI NOCs assisting with 35-count training video to be distributed to all soldiers.
 2. Music: Drum Major Jenkins believes Fife Major Stone is working with recruit fifer, although that is not certain. Fife Major was not on the call. Several musicians are practicing with 4H Fife n Drum. Drum-Major also reported the company plans to meet in the coming week for a check-in.
